INTRODUCTION

Dear Year 11,

We have published this guide to help you plan your revision. We have included a proposed revision schedule for some courses as examples of what you need to do for each of your subjects, as well as blank timetables for you to personalise. You can adapt these proposed schedules as necessary. Each week your tutor will be spending time helping you complete your weekly schedule and checking your progress.

Below is some advice to remind you what you should be doing when revising.

1. Make a revision timetable. Include your school timetable, your exams and key events such as birthdays you don't want to miss.
2. Each revision session should be about 45 minutes long. After this, your concentration lapses and you should take a short break of about ten to fifteen minutes.
3. Check out phone apps, such as 'Exam Countdown' and 'Class Timetable'. 'The Revision World' website also has useful advice.
4. Remember to include rewards in your timetable. For example, four revision sessions might equal a film on NETFLIX.
5. Don't spend ages making a timetable look pretty. Revision timetables shouldn't become a way to avoid doing your revision!
6. Find somewhere quiet to revise – your bedroom or maybe your Gran's house and tell people you don't want any interruptions.
7. Create a distraction free zone, no phone calls, no emails, no social media.
8. Sit at a proper desk or table to revise, not in front of the T.V. Find out if having music on works for you or not.
9. Always start with the most difficult topic; the best concentration is always at the beginning.
10. Do mix up your revision by trying different active learning techniques. Try some of these:
 - Make your own learning mind maps.
 - Make flash cards. Write the facts on one side and questions on the other. Test yourself. Ask others to test you.
 - Make your own summaries of your revision notes.
 - Make 'post it' notes for the most important things and anything you keep forgetting. Put them where you will see them – around your mirror, on the fridge, saved on your phone.
 - Read your revision notes out loud. There are lots on the Web.
 - Use Revision Guides.
 - Teach somebody else the parts you are finding the hardest.
 - Note down things you still don't understand so you can ask your teachers to talk you through them. Never be embarrassed to ask.
11. Stay in good health. Do regular exercise, eat a balanced diet, drink water and get enough sleep – all are good for your brain.

All lessons will continue as normal in the run up to the GCSE exams. We expect you to attend all sessions, fully focused on preparing for exam success. There is still time for significant revision and you have a team of friends, family, mentors and teachers, all dedicated to supporting you; work with us to ensure you do your very best in the Summer exams and achieve results you will be proud of.
